

2023 COACHING POLICY

This Coaching Policy is a working document. Alterations may occur due to any changes in the BHNC Constitution and/or new Executive or Committee members.

NOTIFICATION OF CLUB TEAMS

Team list containing player contact details are handed out at the Coaches Meeting which is held either late February or early March depending on the competition calendar for that season.

Coaches are required to contact their team/s players within 5 days following the meeting. Notification of training day and time will be provided at that point of contact.

CLUB TRAINING

All training days and times are determined by the Coach and are non-negotiable.

All our Coaches are volunteers many have either work, university, or family commitments plus some have their own training attendance requirements.

All team members are required to be available for the day/time for training as set down by the Coach. Consideration MAY be given, in exceptional circumstances, to players who are unavailable for the day/time set by the Coach. A decision about non-availability will be made in the best interest of the team, and in consultation with the Coach, Coaching Coordinator and/or Club President.

COACHES SEASON REPORT

At the completion of the season all Junior Coaches are required to submit the standardised Coach Report on Player Performance for that season to the BHNC Coaching Coordinator.

COMPETITION COURT TIME

It is our club policy that Coaches ensure players receive equal court time, considering player availability across the 14 or 15 rounds of the competition.

During the Finals series Coaches are encouraged to play their best team combination/s to gain the best result possible and for the team to progress.

CLUB COACH ACCREDITATION

All Coaches must have completed the NSW Foundation Coaching Course online & abide by the Netball Australia Coaches Code of Behaviour.
